**COMMUNICATION**

*"List Serves" - these come to you unless you have "opted out" of being notified*

***District - weekly, generally Friday***

***Principal (Mike Lehmann)- weekly, generally Thursday***

***Athletic Director (Ian Lamont) - weekly, generally Friday***

***Pacer Parents (Cay Borduin) - as requested by parent and student groups to notify and give more information to parents about where they can support, attend, encourage student activities.***

*Daily Bulletin*

*- on the Lakeridge web-site*

*- cannot be sent TO you, you need to visit Ed-Line or Lakeridge web-site*

*Video monitors at school*

*- for students - daily bulletin posted, other information about activities*

***MUST DO - go to Back to School Night (Sept. 21) to meet teachers, hear how they communicate***

*- in general, let students handle first. Order of notification - contact teacher, contact counselor - email best or personal appointment for student*

**Academics**

EDLINE - Freshman parents receive Edline Identification info at back to school night or in the front office to log on and monitor student progress

*- caveat - not always completely up to date but almost all teachers are using this*

*Turnitin.com - social studies - student must have their log-on information (distributed from their social studies classes)*

Blue Day / White Day / Assembly Schedule - all info on the Lakeridge web-site; student planner has some information, parent directory has information as well

PEERS - schedule to be announced

### **General**

Parking - in visitor spots or on high attendance days, in the student parking lot areas NOT in numbered parking spots (except after hours)

### **Achievement/Recognition**

*Example: Student of the quarter - save in a file starting as a freshman. You will need these for college applications when student is a senior (and your student will forget a number of activities they have participated in)*

### **Social**

*Dances, school activities - keep the student involved*

*- Pick up on time*

*- Volunteer - you might not be called, you might say no, but school needs help with the financial situation it is in*

### **Parent School Support Organizations**

*Pacer Club - umbrella organization; 5 meetings per year, 6:30-7:30 -see web-site for schedule*

*Pacer Athletics - sports*

*POPS, TAPS , TOPS - performing arts, theater arts, band, etc.*
